PRIYADARSHNI ACADEMY'S LITERARY AWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS EVENT

The Academy's 34th Anniversary Literary Awards and Scholarships program was held on March 14 at the Walchand Hirachand Hall. The event with attendance of nearly 250 audience members consisting of leading literary figures, educationists, businessmen, parents, teachers, and the media, was jam-packed.

The event was graced by none other than the Governor of Maharashtra, Shri CH. Vidyasagar Rao, who honored the Academy with his gracious presence as Chief Guest.

He profusely commended the Academy and its leadership on the wonderful work they are doing to make a useful and important contribution to society. The Honorable Governor spoke about the rich literary and educational traditions of Maharashtra which contributed to the cultivation of values, emphasized patriotism, and helped preserve our cultural heritage.

He referred to the pride of place India has among world languages. He opined that people who study in their own languages are more likely to pursue their educational aspirations.

He pointed out that, in the U.S., educational institutions are run successfully on corporate and other endowments. He said that it is an example which should be emulated by corporate leaders and philanthropists in India for institutions to be adequately funded to soundly support academic programs.

Mr. Hiranandani welcomed the Honorable Governor and the guests and spoke about the immense contributions the Governor has made to furthering the cause of education in the state of Maharashtra.

Mr. Nanik Rupani, Chairman Emeritus, Priyadarshni Academy, expressed immense thankfulness to the Hon'ble Governor for responding to the Academy's invitation. Mr. Rupani gave the highlights of the Academy. He had a request to make to the Governor. As students are being charged 18% GST on professional courses not recognised by the Universities, he requested the Hon'ble Governor to take up the issue with the higher authorities. As these courses can provide good employment opportunities to the students, no GST should be charged on fees for special courses, he added.

Literary awards for work in the Hindi, Sindhi and Gujarati languages were presented to Mr. Hastimal Hasti, Ms. Maya Rahi and Dr. Pravin Darji respectively for their outstanding contributions to writings and teaching in these languages. Dr. Narendra Jadhav, a leading light in the literary world of Mahasrashtra, was selected for the Balasaheb Thackeray Marathi literary award. Because Dr. Jadhav was unwell, he could not attend the ceremony. He will be presented the award next year.

Mr. Hastimal Hasti, Hindi literary awardee, was born in Aamet, Rajasthan.

He is a well-known poet who has written five collections of poetry. One of Mr. Hasti's gazals "naye parindon ko udane men vakt toh lagata hai " was sung by the gazal great, Mr. Jagjit Singh.

The Gujarati literary award winner was Padma Shri Dr. Pravin Darji who is a prolific writer in the world of Gujarati literature. He has covered the entire gamut of written literature - poetry, creative essays, literary criticism, research methodology, editing, translating, et al. He has engaged himself in creative writing since the year 1962 and has always believed in dwelling on something new and uncommon. He has 131 books to his credit.

His selected works have been prescribed in schools as textbooks by the textbook boards of Gujarat and Maharashtra. His creative works form a part of the curriculum at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels of several universities in Gujarat and Mumbai.

The Government of India awarded him the Padma Shri in 2011 for his noteworthy contributions to the field of literature and education.

Ms. Maya Rahi, Sindhi literary awardee, is a writer who has made a significant contribution to promoting Sindhi literature over a phenomenal 60 years. She was born in Quetta, Baluchistan.

She received awards for Muhabat Jo Mee Hun and Dhaal from the National Council for Promotion of Sindhi Language and a Sahitya Academy Award for Mahingi Murk.

Each literary award carried a purse of ₹25,000/- and a plaque.

186 scholarships to deserving and financially needy students pursuing different fields of study were also presented. Most of the scholarships were for ₹20,000 and ₹10,000. For the first time, Priyadarshni Academy gave scholarships to two students of social work, with a view to sensitize the youth to the needs of the society.

The literary awardees thanked the Academy and spoke about the contribution it is making by giving awards in different languages without regional biases. Sindhi awardee, Ms. Maya Rahi, said that she is proud to receive the award. She stated that "when Sindhis came to new India post-partition, they suffered a lot of hardships. But when Sindhis have an institution like Priyadarshni Academy, we don't need any other help."

Mr. Rahul Karad, Vice President, MAEER's MIT Group of Institutions, said that the Academy is contributing to the networking of the minds and hearts of people from different regional cultures, through its literary and scholarships programs. He cited the example of Dr. R. A. Mashelkar, noted scientist, who is currently the Chairman of Priyadarshni Academy's Global Awards Advisory Committee. Dr. Mashelkar studied under street lights with a scholarship from the Tatas with only his poor mother to support him. He has now become a Director in one of the Tata companies. He suggested that Priyadarshni Academy track those achievers and students who received awards and scholarships who have now become important contributors to society and have them speak from this same forum to inspire others.

Mrs. Shilpa Karia, psychologist, also addressed the audience.

The program ended with Dr. Mohanbhai Patel, Former Sheriff of Mumbai, and Chairman of the Gujarati Literary Awards Committee, providing a summary and proposing a Vote of Thanks.



Dr. Mashelkar to be Judge for Queen Elizabeth Prize in Engineering




Dr. Mashelkar will be in the eminent panel of judges, which will decide on the prize that is considered to be equivalent to Nobel Prize in Engineering, namely, the most prestigious Queen Elizabeth Prize in Engineering.

The prize of one million pounds (approx ₹ 9 crores 23 lakh) is given biannually to a global game changing engineering innovation.

The inaugural prize in 2013 had gone to the inventors of the Internet, Browser and World Wide Web, who received the award at the hands of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth.
